Deep, dark red colour with tints of black and purple. The bouquet shows dominant oak at first, while the palate is full-bodied and rich, dense and fleshy, with quite a lot of oak apparent.

The tannins, oak and acidity combine to impart a touch of astringency. Raspberry fruit comes through on the nose with time in the glass. There is concentration and richness here. A good decant is recommended.
