Zema Estate Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2019

Homework for the week. Take a bottle of this and a bottle of their Estate Shiraz, both 2019 and both ridiculous value, and work out your preference. Line ball for me. Love them both. This Coonawarra Cab saw eighteen months in French hogsheads.

A wine with concentration, focus and balance, the colour is an opaque maroon. The nose has black fruits, espresso, hints of chinotto, dried herbs and tobacco leaves. Supple texture with a fine line of acidity and lingering finish. Good intensity runs the length here. Enjoy over the next ten years and more.

Great buying and like the Estate Shiraz, five years under its belt already.
Whichever you choose, you can't lose.
